# REGULATIONS



ORGANISED BY SOLWAY CAR CLUB LTD



A ROUND OF THE FIVE OF CLUBS RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP

1. Solway Car Club Ltd will organise a National 'B' Permit Special Stage Rally on Sunday 15 August 2010. The event will start and finish at the Military Ranges, Dundrennan, near Kirkcudbright. The event will be a qualifying round of the Five of Clubs Rally Championship.

2. The meeting will be governed by the general regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd [incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA], these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

3. MSA Permit Number: 60025  
Scottish Government Authorisation Number: Applied For  
Five of Clubs Championship Permit Number: 2010/5701

4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club, the Association of Scottish Car Clubs, and the Association of North East & Cumbria Car Clubs.

5. Drivers and co-drivers must produce a valid Car Club Membership Card and appropriate Competition Licence at event signing on. [*Minimum licence requirement for the driver is a Stage Rally National B*].

6. Scrutineering will start at 8:00AM on Sunday 15 August at a location on the Military Ranges to be finalised in the Final Instructions. Any Competitor not signed on 30 minutes before by his or her start time may be refused a start. First Car will start at 10:01AM.

7. Cars will start at one minute intervals. A route map will be provided to all competitors. The event will have a total mileage of approximately 55 miles, and will contain 8 special stages totalling approximately 36 miles. The stages will be timed to an accuracy of less than one minute in accordance with R31.1.3. The stages will take the form of 95% sealed military range roads and 5% loose surface roads.

8. The event will consist of 4 classes as follows:

Class 1: Cars up to and including 1400cc

Class 2: Cars 1401cc up to and including 1700cc

Class 3: Cars 1701cc up to and including 2100c

Class 4: Cars 2101cc & over

*(Turbo charged cars treated as per Blue Book for class eligibility, i.e. capacity x 1.7)*

9. Awards will be presented as follows:

1st & 2nd Overall: Trophy for Driver and Co-driver

1st, 2nd & 3rd in Class: Trophy for Driver and Co-driver

*[First and second overall will not be eligible for class awards.]*

Highest placed 2-wheel drive vehicle: The Arden House Trophy

Highest Placed Lady Driver: A Trophy

*[If no Lady Driver finishes, the award will be given to the highest placed Lady Co-driver.]*

Highest placed Solway CC Driver: The Solway Coast Trophy \*

Highest Placed Solway CC Co-Driver: The Tom Boyd Memorial Trophy \*

*[\* These trophies will be presented at the Solway Car Club Annual Prizegiving in January, and can only be won by to competitors who were members of Solway Car Club before the publication of these regulations.]*

10. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes finally on Monday 9 August 2010. The entry fee is £224, which includes all documentation, decals, and contribution to marshal's fund. All entries must be on the Official Entry Form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee.

11. Entries withdrawn will receive a refund at the discretion of the organisers, minus a fee to cover administration costs.

12. The maximum entry for the meeting is 50. The minimum is 25. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.

15. Provisional results will be published in the Arden House Hotel, Tongland Road, Kirkcudbright, DG6 4UU, as soon as possible following the end of the event. Prizegiving will take place here as soon as the results are final.

16. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C5, and Appeals made in accordance with C6.

17. Entrants will be supplied with a Road Book and Time Card at signing on. These documents will provide all the information necessary as per regulation R2.3.2 + R33. Servicing will be permitted in areas specified in the final instructions.

18. Target timing will apply as per R31.2. Timing of controls will be to the previous whole minute. Timing of special stages will be to the previous whole second.

19. Penalties will be applied according to R32.2, specifically:

Maximum cumulative lateness:	<u>15 minutes (penalty free)</u>
Each minute <u>under</u> target time on road section:	<u>1 minute</u>
Not reporting at a control:	<u>Exclusion</u>

20. Insurance: We have applied to Lockton Companies International Ltd for a Blanket cover note under the MOTOR SPORTS CLUB SCHEME. This will give third party and passenger liability cover for the event, provided the driver can comply with the following declaration:

- Over 21 years of age and held a full driver's licence for at least 6 months.
- Not more than one fault accident in the last six months.
- No more than six speeding points on your licence.
- No physical or mental disabilities.
- There are no other material facts to disclose which are likely to influence the acceptance or assessment of risk.

If you are **unable to comply** with any of the above points, you must complete a declaration form [available from the Entries Secretary] and forward it to Lockton **prior** to the event, allowing sufficient time for a letter of acceptance to be issued to you before Sunday 15 August 2010.

21. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be supplied by the organisers on the day.

22. Pre-event practicing or testing over the Special Stages on this event is forbidden (R5.1.4 + R26.7.)
